<b>LOGLINE:</b>	A teenage Mind Reader enters a prestigious magical academy and must overcome his infamous family legacy while navigating a deeply divided society to find his destiny.
<b>SUMMARY:</b>	<p>The story follows Jimmy Osan, a fourteen-year-old Mind Reader. He is accepted to Zyfred Academy of Diverse Magic, despite his deceased father's controversial reputation for attempting to dismantle the rigid magical caste system.</p> <p>On his first day, he meets Camille, a confident Sorceress who challenges the prejudice of her peers and defends him publicly. Their budding friendship is tested by the rigid "Chain of Powers" system where Mind Readers are the lowest of a system ruled by Sorcerers, Mermaids, Fairies, and Goblins.</p> <p>As Jimmy navigates school life, bullies, and teachers with an agenda, he begins to understand and appreciate his father's legacy and the dangers of the systemic divisions within the magical society.</p>
<b>SUGGESTED FORMAT:</b>	Episodic Series, Streaming
<b>COMMENTARY:</b>	<p>This story is a nice blend of coming-of-age and fantasy with larger political and social undertones about hierarchy, identity, and reform.</p> <p>Filled with strong lead characters, plenty of built in conflict between the different groups, a high school format that allows for multiple episodes and seasons, and a great dynamic between the two leads Jimmy and Camille.</p> <p>The book is dialogue driven, which is good for character building. It will need to be expanded visually to make the scenes more cinematic.</p>
